

Listen to your Vet!

Bedding is one of the key elements to long term good health for your horse. The following should be important, but many times are overlooked in good stall management.



1) **LOW DUST**—Select a bedding with the lowest amount of dust possible. Your horse may spend 12 to 20 hours a day in its stall. Wood dust is a carcinogen and at very least wood dust is the primary cause of equine allergies. SUNCOAST® large flake is considered an ultra low dust bedding.

2) **AIR QUALITY**—Ammonia odors are more than just unpleasant. Strong ammonia odors can create an unhealthy environment for your horse and have a negative effect on performance and respiratory health. (National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health) SUNCOAST® Bedding's natural pine scent will help neutralize those odors.

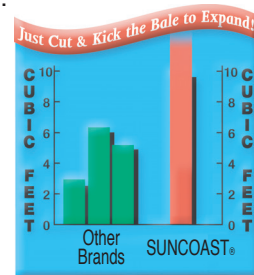
3) **DRY**—Select a bedding that is not wet. Wet bedding will contain molds spores that can compromise the airways of your horse, SUNCOAST® is high heat dried between 800° and 900° to provide sanitized, dry flakes.

4) **PURE PINE**—is and has been the #1 bedding of choice for generations. Pine will naturally neutralize a large amount of urine odor. As a second line of defense we suggest is SUNCOAST® Cedar Shavings. One bale of SUNCOAST® Cedar divided among three stalls will add a fresh cedar smell to the stall. Cedar provides natural, organic odor control and insect repellent without the high cost & worry of chemicals.



5) **VALUE**—More is less with SUNCOAST®. Each bale of SUNCOAST® Bedding will contain twice as much as other brands. Ultra compressed SUNCOAST® Bedding utilizes a manufacturing process that provides more shavings in each Bale by unique compression technology.
